

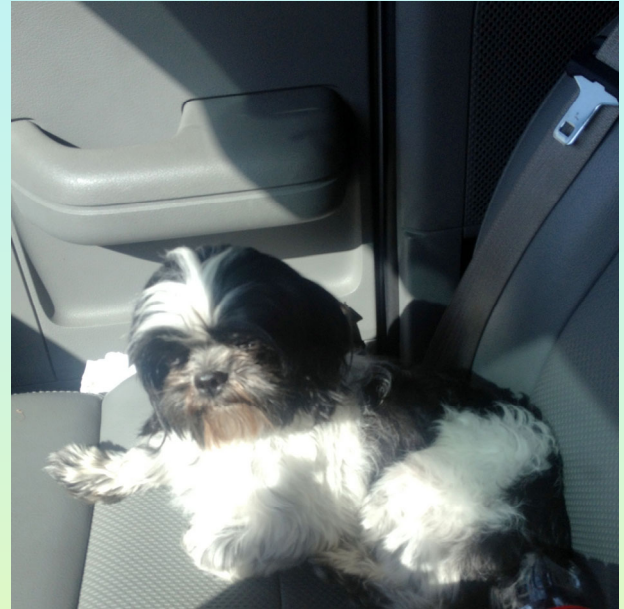


BE KIND AND LEAVE YOUR PET BEHIND.

75	100	10 minutes
75	120	30 minutes
85	90	5 minutes
85	100	7-10 minutes
85	120	30 minutes
100	140	15 minutes



Pets do not sweat they pant and release heat through their pads on their feet. If they are in a hot car standing on a hot seat they can not cool themselves down.

Dogs left in cars body temperatures rise with in minutes. Dogs and cats will suffer from nerve damage, heart problems, liver damage, brain damage and even death.

A FORM OF CRUELTY – You could have your car damaged, your pet removed from your custody, charged with a crime, and fined or imprisoned.

IF YOU SEE A DISTRESSED PET IN A CAR YOU SHOULD;

Write down the vehicle information and what time it is; license plate number, make, model. Take a photo if possible.

Alert the store manager have them call the person over the loud speakers. (safety of the pet is our main concern).

Call the Flagler County Sheriff's office. (386)313-4911 or 911 for emergencies.

Stay with the vehicle until help arrives.
