PROGRAM MISSION

Provides those law enforcement services to the community which preserve and protect life and property; enforces city, county, state and federal statutes, ordinances and laws; investigates criminal activities; apprehends criminals and recovers stolen property; provides programs to educate the public in crime prevention, and processes all parking citations.

PROGRAM ANALYSIS

During FY2001, the Flagler County Sheriff's Department, at a cost of \$738,279, provided law enforcement services for the City of Palm Coast. This included establishing a sub-station within the City and providing eleven (11) posts, or eighteen (18) officers to cover the entire City. FY2002 is essentially the same dollar amount, but is based upon the cost to supplement the countywide base level of service with two (2) additional patrol zones and a portion of the costs of supervision, as well as the Palm Coast precinct.
