The Adopt-A-Median program is an opportunity for the community to get involved, and help beautify Palm Coast! The Adopter may chose a residential median within city limits to beautify by planting small trees, groundcovers, and wildflowers. Anyone can adopt, and together, every median in Palm Coast can be uniquely beautiful.



Adopter Responsibilities:

- ✓ Obtain the supplies you will need (the City does not provide them).
- ✓ If you plant trees, make sure they're being pruned regularly and properly.
- ✓ Maintain the grass at 4 inches.
- ✓ Abide by the Safety Guidelines that can be found on the Partnership Agreement.
- ✓ Don't adopt the median for the wrong reasons.



Why Adopt?

Adopting is a great way to get active, improve the community, increase property values, and create something beautiful to look at throughout your daily routine. If you encounter a median that needs attention, adopting it can be a fun way to get outside, and feel good about the beautiful outcome.

How to Adopt:

Adopting a median is easy. Simply contact the City regarding the median you would like to adopt, receive the paperwork, read it, fill it out, return it, and when approved, you may begin your beautification goals.

Maintenance

Adopting the median means adopting the responsibility to maintain it. In addition to maintaining the grass at a height of four inches, maintenance of the median includes: regularly watering the grass, watering the plants/trees often until they're established, removing dead plants/trees, and pruning the trees properly.

It is important that you do not block the right of way while working on the median.
