#### **Emergency Procedures**



Friendly reminder on our First Aid, Injury & Weather Emergency Procedures:

If someone is injured on court, please send for a staff member immediately and do not try to move the person if they are on the ground; this could cause

further injury. If emergency services are assisting, please give the injured person privacy and vacate the court. If you are a witness to an incident, staff will contact you in order to gain more information about what occurred.



Severe weather/lightning: If lightning is seen please vacate courts and come inside the tennis center building immediately. If you hear thunder please vacate court and seek shelter under pavilion or inside building until 30 minutes after last thunder is heard.

#### Summer Monthly Pass

This summer, we will be offering a monthly pass option for guest of the facility during the summer. This option will be available from June 1 through Sept. 30 for \$50 per month.
