Pink Army 5K Run/Walk

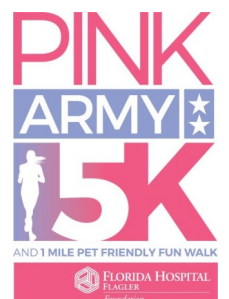
