To start, I want to say thank you! Not only for your continued support, but also for working with us this past year and for being a part of our family. September 30 marked the end of our fiscal year for the PCTC. This year we have managed to accomplish many feats:

- Successfully hosted the "Palm Coast Men's Futures Tournament: A USTA Pro Circuit Event", receiving extremely high marks from USTA officials about how the event was run.
- Exceeded our revenue goals by 4% this past fiscal year, generating \$156,000 in revenue.
- Increased our benefits of being a Pass Holder: offering social events throughout the year and providing discounts for clinics and the pro shop.
- Increased participation in our kids' clinics tremendously over the past year.
- Hosted one high school and two kids' tournaments.

We are consistently reviewing our processes and trying to make things as easy as possible for the guests at our facility. These feats would not be possible without the amazing staff and those who volunteer at PCTC. I am extremely thankful for everyone who has played a role in making this facility better. Our vision for this facility is not to rest on the laurels of years prior, but to make our facility elite once again. That being said, we have a lot planned for PCTC in this upcoming year:


- There will be over \$100,000 allocated for capital improvement projects throughout the facility for court resurfacing and other maintenance needs.
- The "Palm Coast Men's Futures Tournament: A USTA Pro Circuit Event" has increased from a \$15,000 purse to \$25,000, which will bring higher ranked players.
- Host a special Pass Holder Appreciation Day during the Futures Tournament on Thursday, Jan. 24 (SAVE THE DATE)
- We are in the process of replacing all of the tattered windscreens with new ones.
- Push gates will be installed (between Courts 8 & 9 and between Courts 4 & 7) in the coming months.
- Our goal is to become more involved with the Flagler County School Board and offer more ways for the youth in our community to learn tennis.

We are very excited for this upcoming year and all that we have in store as we continue to work towards achieving our vision for this facility. Thank you once again for being a part of our family!
