- The court resurfacing project was completed. Welch Tennis Courts, Inc. scarified, cleaned, and treated court surfaces with algaecide. They removed existing tape and nails and brought in approximately 15 tons of new clay to each court. They placed the material with laser-guided equipment to provide a smooth even surface. We hope you all enjoy playing on the new surfaces!

Enjoy a movie and pizza party on July 19 from 6-9 p.m.! This free adaptive recreation program is intended for youth and adults with intellectual disabilities.

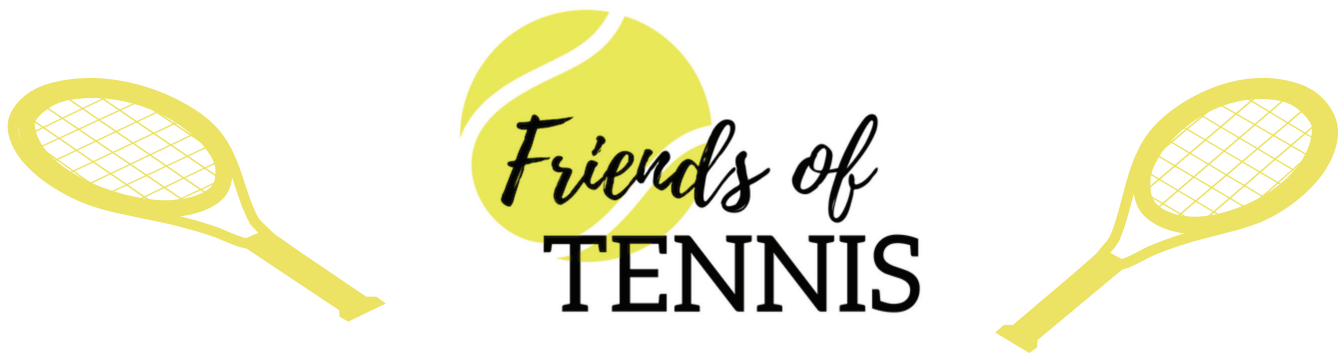
### Youth Fishing Derby
